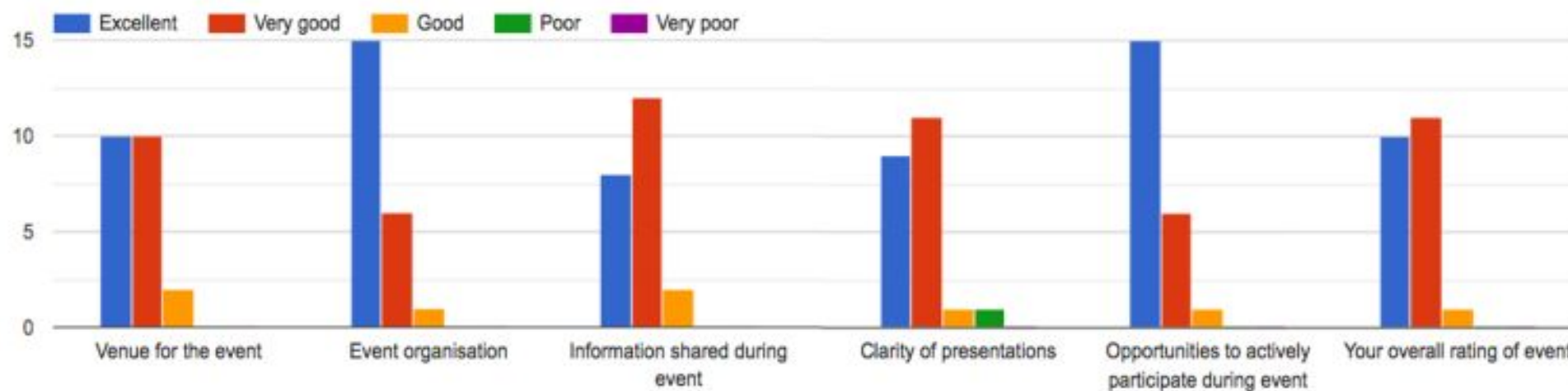
## Feedback I

- Attendees were invited to offer feedback by accessing a Google Form.
- Feedback was sought along six dimensions: (i) the adequacy of the event venue; (ii) the quality of the event organisation; (iii) the relevance of the information shared during the event; (iv) the clarity of presentations; (v) the opportunities for active participation; and (vi) the overall rating of the event.
- Along each dimension, responders could select from a five-point scale (i.e. 'excellent', 'very good', 'good', 'poor' and 'very poor') and add their own comments.
- Feedback was received from 22 out of the 34 attendees.
